

## **What is a Local Reentry Council?**

A Local Reentry Council (LRC) is a structured coalition of government and private entities, individuals, businesses, faith-based and non-profit organizations whose primary objective is to integrate a diverse range of reentry services for justice-involved individuals, aiming to reduce recidivism and victimization, and increase public and community safety.

## **Our Purpose**

We assist individuals with criminal backgrounds of Cumberland County, NC who are reentering the society by providing supportive services and resources for smooth and successful transition into their communities.

- Job Readiness, Employment Assistance and Career Development
- Linkage to Community Resources
- Referral to Vocational/Occupational Skills Training
- Individualized Case Management

## **Who is Eligible for Reentry Council Services?**

All individuals with criminal backgrounds are eligible for services; priority will be given to individuals who are immediately returning from incarceration. Individuals may be referred by probation officers, justice officials, family, community groups and/or self-referrals.
